

Workshop Tuesday 13th June, 10:00 -14:00

Sharing as Caring is a project that sets out to explore how we are affected by economies, politics, technology and emotions, and to try and find ways of "being-in-common".

We will work with artists and writers **Angelika Levi, Miya Yoshida,** and **Susan Turcot,** and have the opportunity to get some insight into their working practices as film makers/curators/visual artists. Taking the nuclear catastrophe in Fukushima as our starting point, the workshop will move between OSE and the nearby beach location to consider sound from 9000km away, use a small fire as a tool to share the experience, and make sand drawings to explore our imaginations and ideas about "being-in-common".
